- 1. The age limit as on date of publication for the direct recruitment to the posts on regular basis shall be as per the prevailing rules of the Government and regulations issued by the Commission from time to time in case of Law Officer.
- 2. For applicants who have retired from services of the State or Central Government, the upper age limit shall be 63 years as per Haryana Government instructions No. 34/01/2004-4GSI dated 06.08.2018 as on the date of publication in case of Director (Technical) and Consultant (Technical).
- 3. The working employees of Government Departments, Public Sector Undertakings / Power Utilities (Centre and States), State Electricity Regulatory Commissions etc. have to apply through proper channel only. The applications of willing candidates working in departments/organizations may kindly be forwarded to this Commission along with the following documents in case of Law Officer.
 - i. Photocopies of the ACRs of the applicants for the last ten years duly attested by an authorized officer.
 - ii. Certificate to the effect that no vigilance enquiry is pending against the concerned official.
 - iii. Certificate to the effect that no penalty was imposed during the last ten years on the candidate official.
 - iv. Certificate to the effect that the integrity of the official remained above board during the last ten years.
 - v. Certificate to the effect that no criminal case has been registered against the applicant in any court.
- 4. If any candidate wishes to apply for more than one post, a separate application shall be submitted for each post, otherwise the application will not be entertained.
- 5. Candidates are required to mention the category under which the application is being submitted along with documentary evidence such as Educational Qualification, Date of Birth and Experience etc. Reservation and relaxation benefits, wherever applicable, shall be admissible strictly in accordance with the Haryana Government policy/instructions issued from time to time. In case no reservation applies, the post shall be treated as unreserved.
- 6. An eligible officer as well as candidates who are retired or likely to retire within six months at the time of advertisement may also apply for the post of Director (Technical).
- 7. Application of non-eligible candidates shall be rejected outright. In case any information furnished by the candidate is found to be false or misleading, his/her candidature shall be cancelled at any stage of recruitment and, if already appointed, services shall be liable to termination without any notice.

Haryana Electricity Regulatory Commission (Engagement of Consultants) Regulations, 2007.

- 9. Initially, the contractual period for contractual posts shall be six months, which may be extended by the competent authority from time to time depending on the requirement and performance.
- 10. If the work and conduct of the officer/official engaged on contractual/deputation basis is not found satisfactory, the contract shall be liable to termination immediately without any advance notice and without any claim for compensation.
- 11. No TA/DA shall be admissible for appearing in any test/interview in connection with this recruitment.
- 12. The Commission reserves the right not to proceed with the recruitment process for contractual or regular basis for any of the above posts in case of non-suitability of the candidate or on any other administrative ground at any stage without any advance notice or assigning any reason. The decision of the Commission regarding eligibility, shortlisting, selection and appointment shall be final and binding on all candidates and shall not be liable to challenge except as provided under law.
